

# 2021 Annual Program Update

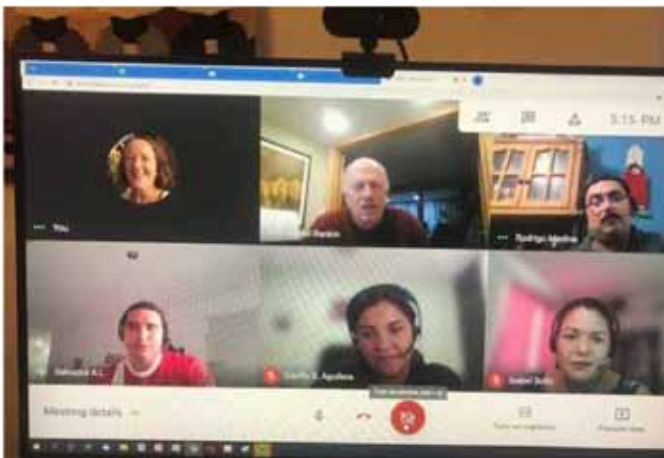
## OVERCOMING THE COVID CHALLENGE

We are pleased to report that even in this difficult year, **90%** of the students enrolled in the Progreso Apoyo Program improved their grades from the previous semester and/or maintained an overall grade point average of 8 or better (out of 10) for the school year.



## VIRTUAL MATH/SCIENCE TUTORING PROGRAM

To help our students overcome challenges learning math and science via distance learning, we created a virtual math/science tutoring program. **All six students** enrolled in the program raised their grade point average by at least one point.



## VIRTUAL ENGLISH PROGRAM LOOKS TO THE FUTURE

Our successful Virtual English Program will continue into the summer and through the coming year. We have plans to develop an on-campus English Language Program at all three of Progreso's middle schools.

## COMPUTERS COMING TO PROGRESO SECONDARY SCHOOLS!

With support from two local Rotary Clubs, as well as a Rotary Club District in the USA, we are getting ready to install **30 new computers** in the three middle schools in Progreso.
